This participant handbook has been compiled as a guide to members of their **commitment and responsibilities** in relation to participation in this enrichment program.

The Football Development Program provides an opportunity for students to train with other students of a similar high standard with a shared goal of striving for excellence in football. All members should be role models for all students and engender respect from their peers.

The Membership Agreement

The "Membership Agreement" is an important document that should be completed and returned to the school office prior to the first session on Term 1, 2021. This document is a record of parental approval for students to be involved in the football program.

Successful applicants are required to be available to represent the school in any NSW CHSSA Carnival, game or competition for which she/he is selected.

Core Rules of Discipline in Government Schools

Students participating in the Talented Football Program will adhere to the Core Rules of Discipline in NSW Government Schools.

- a) Comply with instructions given by coaches and teachers at all times. Attend every possible session, **be punctual** and prepared to actively participate and learn.
- b) Maintain a neat appearance adhering to the requirements of the program regarding uniform. Only wear training gear and change into school clothing after training.
- c) Behave in a respectful, responsible and successful manner with a focus on safety.
- d) Show respect at all times for the program, other participants and the coach.
- e) Treat other students and adults involved in the program with dignity and respect.
- f) Care for training gear, property belonging to yourself, the school and others.
- g) At all times work and behave to the best of your ability.
- h) Coaching staff will have access to basic student information such as attendance, medical information and non-completed assessment tasks. Students who fail to meet acceptable school and class standards will not be selected for representative teams.

Note: The department has a duty of care to all students, and provides a safe and secure learning environment for all of its students, including where the student is involved in an approved activity away from his school. Behaviour by a student that affects the safety of others, such as harassment, bullying, violence and illegal or anti-social behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated.

Program information

Training will **cost \$800 a year** for two one hour sessions a week over four terms from 7.15am to 8.15am. All training payments must be made in full by Week 2, Term 1, 2021.

Participants must purchase a compulsory one off **kit, for a fee of \$150 which** includes, quality training bag, water bottle, two pairs of socks, two shorts and two training jerseys. Player fittings will take place Week 1, Term 1, 2021.

A **\$50 enrolment fee** must be paid to the school office by **16th December 2020** with a signed application form to hold player positions in the program. The \$50 enrolment will be deducted from the \$800 program fee (ie, the remaining \$750 is due in Week 2, Term 1, 2021).

Late 2021 registrations will need pre-approval from Mr Miller, FDP Coordinator, before applications are approved on 9822 1430 or via email to: cecilhills-h.school@det.nsw.edu.au

All training will be conducted at Cecil Hills HS facilities.

All training equipment will be provided by Cecil Hills HS.

Players will be graded in the first weeks of the program to be placed into suitable training groups by Week 4. Participants will have the opportunity to be selected to represent the school in various football competitions throughout the year.

Holiday programs and football development team competitions will be an additional cost. **Costs will be subsidised by the school.**

The program will commence as of Term 1, 2021 at school. Participants must sign the membership handbook with an agreement which outlines expectations of student conduct for those taking part in the program.

Students are to attend every session, even when it is raining. Wet weather may require the session to be taken undercover in the school gym (students need indoor soccer shoes and football boots for each session). No refunds will be made for missed sessions. **Students will have the opportunity to participate in other sessions to catch up on missed sessions.**

By signing the attached agreement outlined on the back of this page, **you are committing to the program for the entire year.**

Note that this is separate to any other sport associated programs within the school.

This is a fantastic opportunity for our students to engage in an area of passion and to improve their footballing skills with direct access to connected, professional coaches.
